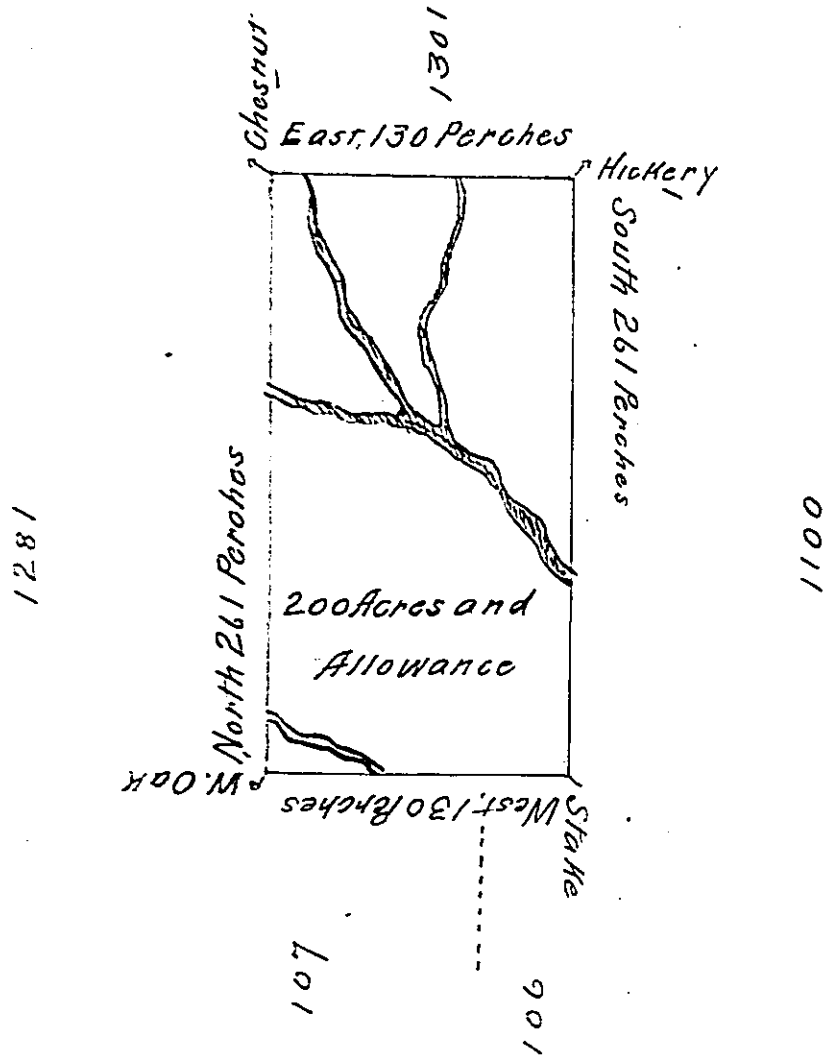


DONATION-LAND, IN DISTRICT NO 6.

 State of Pennsylvania, passed the twenty-fourth Day of February 1785,
 intitled, 'An Act for directing the Mode of distributing the Donation-
 Lands promised to the Troops by this Commonwealth, and by Order
 of the Surveyor General, with the Approbation of the Honourable
 the Executive Council, I have Surveyed, on the Second Day of Decem-
 ber 1785, the above described Tract of Two hundred Acres of
 Land, and Allowance of Six per Cent for Roads, &c. N^o. 1163
 Situate in District N^o. 6. on the West Side of the Allegheny River, in
 the County of Westmoreland. —
