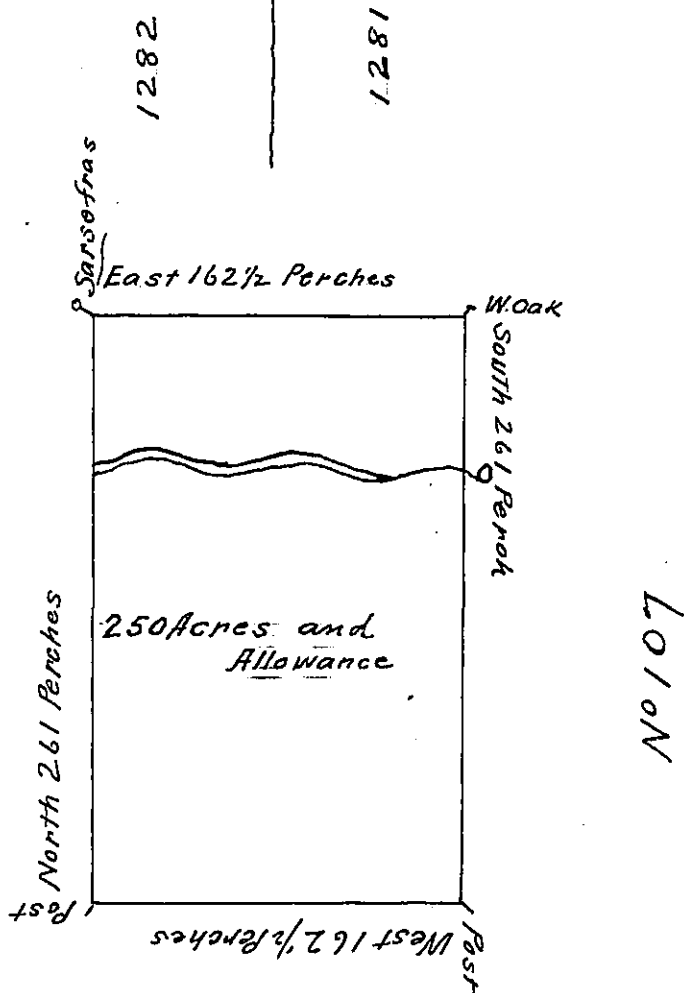


DONATION-LAND, in DISTRICT No 6

In Pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania, passed the twenty-fourth Day of February 1785, intitled, 'An Act for directing the Mode of distributing the Donation-Lands promised to the Troops by this Commonwealth, and by Order of the Surveyor General, With the Approbation of the Honourable the Executive-Council, I have Surveyed, on the Fourth day of December 1785, the above described Tract of Two hundred and fifty Acres of Land, and Allowance of Six per Cent for Roads, &c, No 108. Situate in District No 6, on the West Side of the Allegheny River. in the County of Westmoreland.
