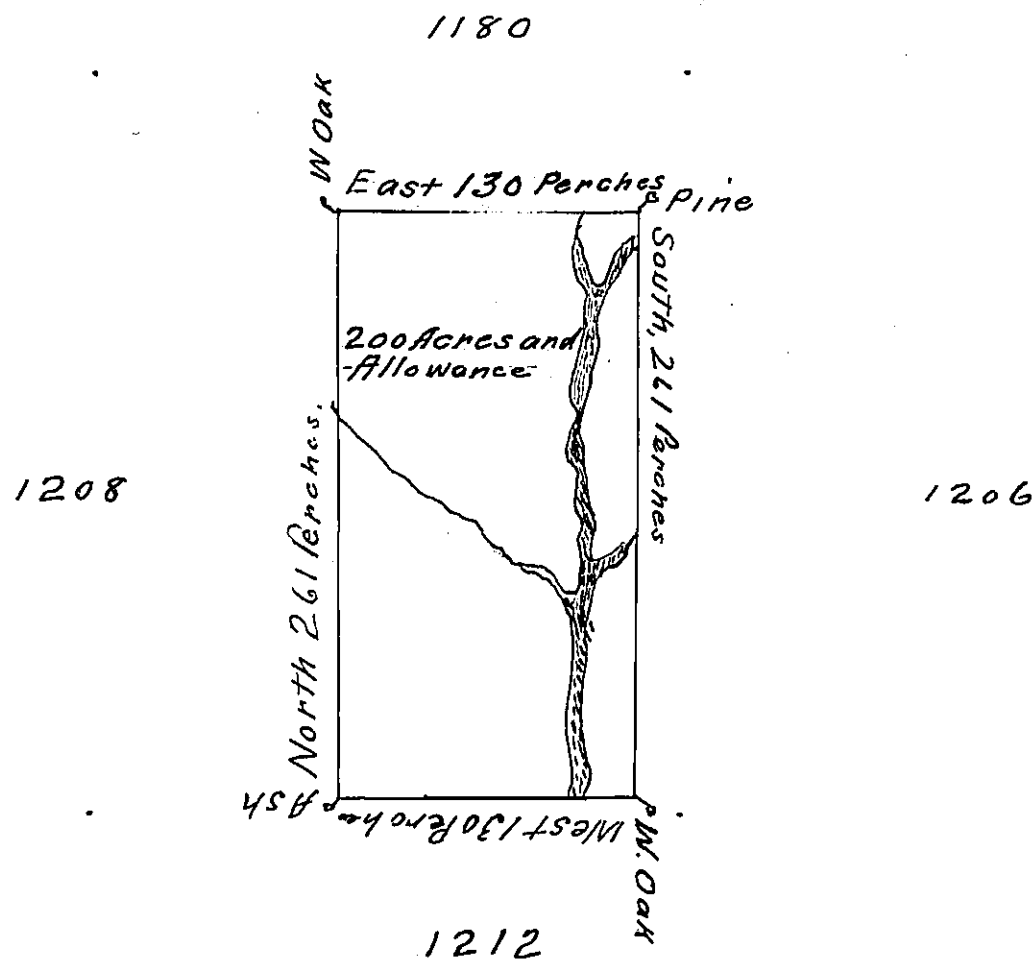


DONATION-LAND, in DISTRICT No 6,  
Lot, No. MCCVII.



In Pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the  
State of Pennsylvania, passed the twenty-fourth Day of February 1785,  
intitled, 'An Act for directing the Mode of distributing the Donation-  
Lands promised to the Troops by this Commonwealth,' and by Order  
of the Surveyor-General, with the Approbation of the Honourable the  
Executive-Council, I have Surveyed, on the Twenty First Day of  
November, 1785, the above described Tract of Two hundred  
Acres of Land, and Allowance of Six per Cent for Roads, &c.  
No 1207, Situate in District No, 6, on the West Side of the  
Allegheny River, in the County of Westmoreland,  
John Lukens, Esq. Jas Chrystie Deputy  
Surveyor-General. Surveyor
