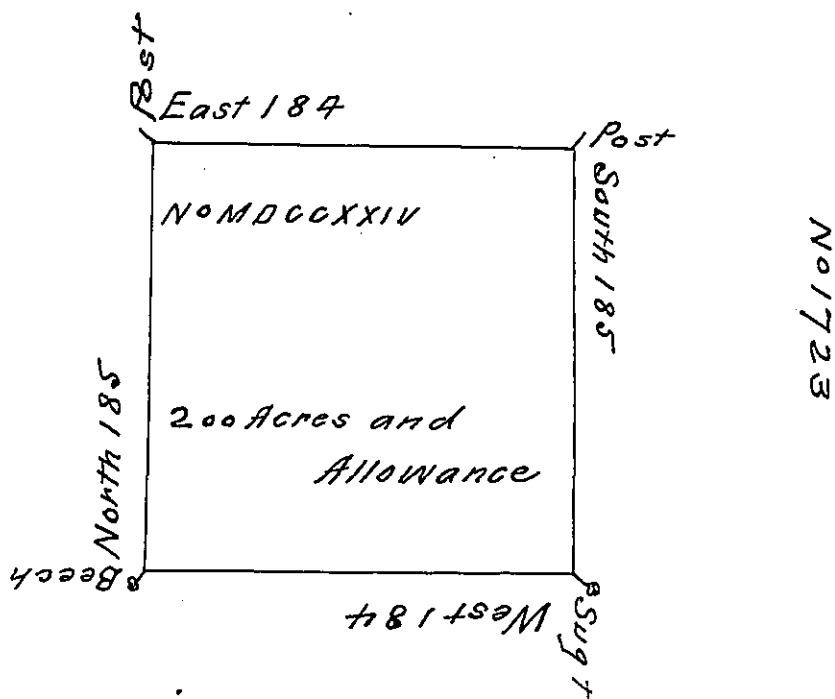

In Pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania, passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February, 1785, entitled "An Act for directing the mode of distributing the Donation Lands promised the Troops of this Commonwealth", and by order of the Surveyor General with the approbation of the Honourable the Supreme Executive Council, I have Surveyed on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of November, 1785, the above described Tract of two hundred acres of land, and allowance of Six percent, for roads, &c, No 1724 Situate in District No. 8. on the West Side of the Allegany River, in the County of Westmoreland.
