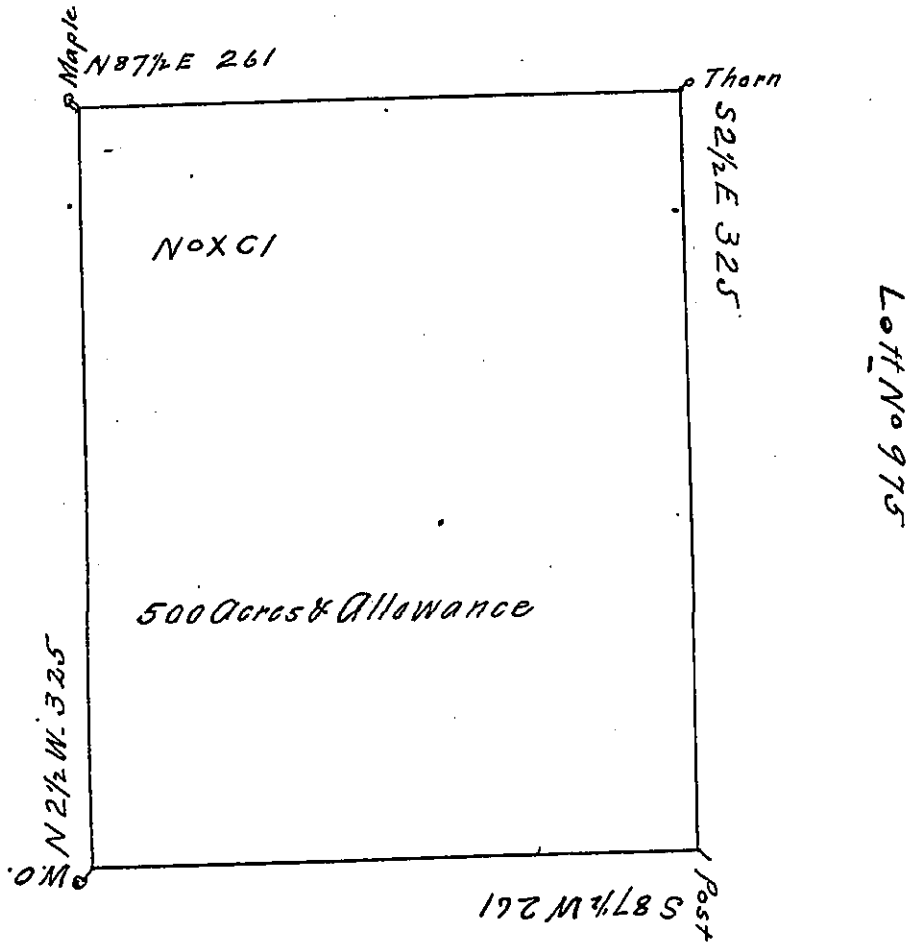

In Pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania, passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of Feby. 1785, Entitled an Act for directing the mode of distributing the Donation Lands promised the Troops of this Commonwealth: & by order of the Surveyor General with the Approbation of the Hon<sup>ble</sup> the Executive Council: I have Surveyed ~~Have Surveyed~~ on the 4<sup>th</sup> day of October 1785, the above described Tract of five Hundred Acres of Land & Allowance of Six per Cent for roads &c N<sup>o</sup> XCI, Situate in District N<sup>o</sup> 5 on the West Side of the Allegany river in the County of Westmoreland.
