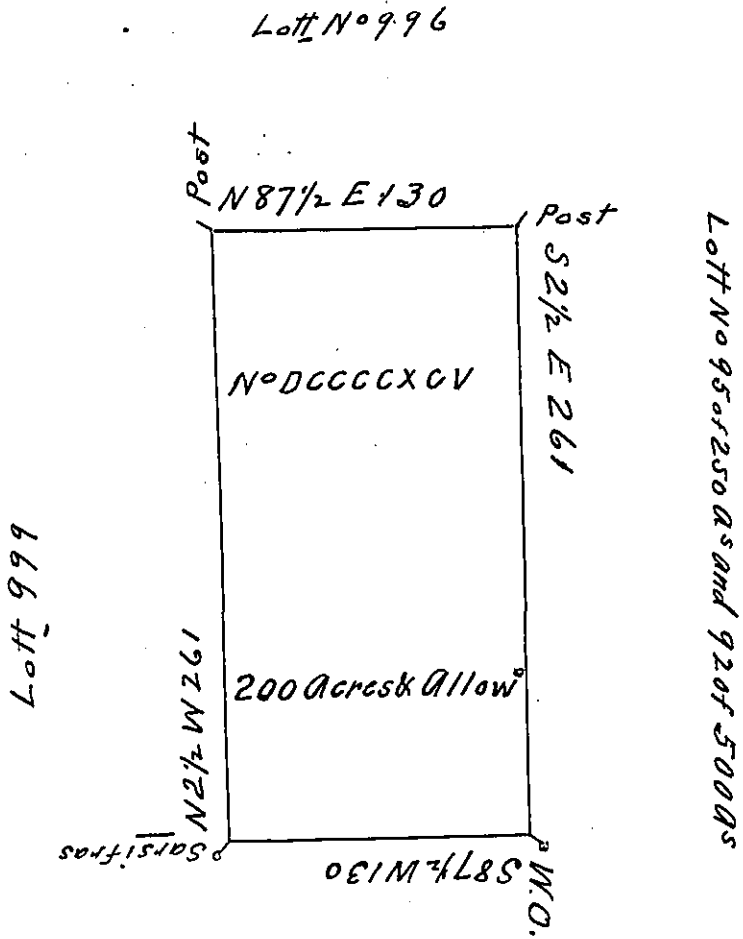


Robt. Frazer Assignee of Fred Winkler

In Pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of
 the State of Pennsylvania, passed the 24th day of February 1785,
 entitled an Act for directing the Mode of distributing the Donation
 Lands promised the Troops of this Commonwealth, and by Order of
 Surveyor General with the Approbation of the
 the Honble the Executive Council. I have Surveyed on the 8th day of
 October 1785, the above described Tract of two Hundred Acres of
 Land & Allowance of Six per Cent for Roads &c, No DCCCCXCV, Situate in
 Distribt No 5, on the West Side of the Allegany river in the County of
 Westmoreland.
