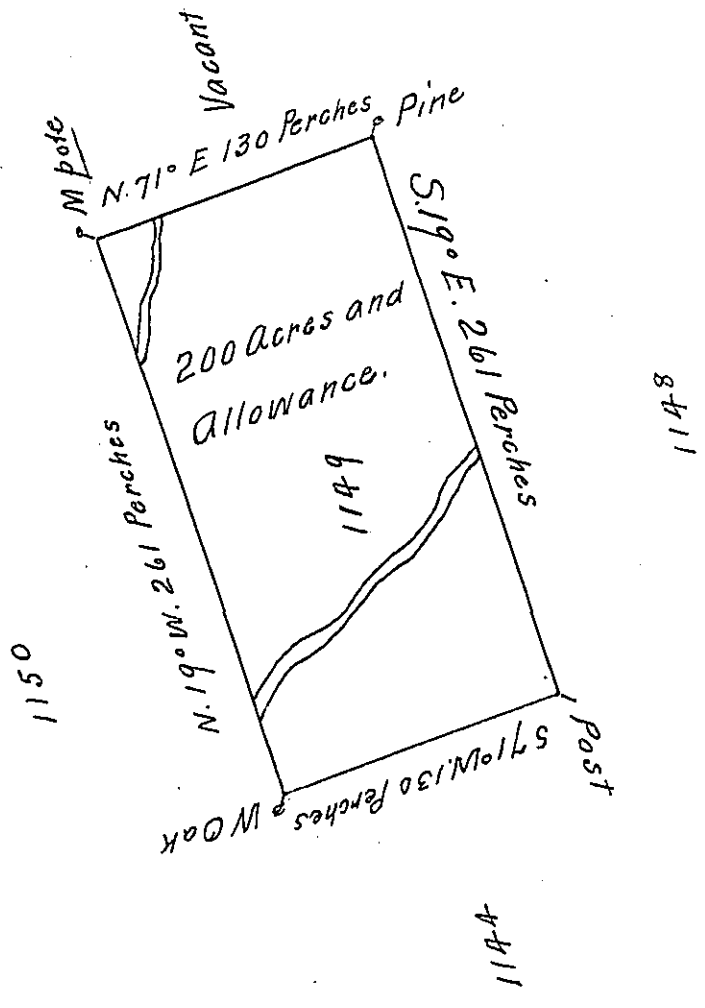


DONATION-LAND, in DISTRICT No 6.

In pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania, passed the twenty-fourth Day of February 1785, intituled, 'An Act for directing the Mode of distributing the Donation-Lands promised to the Troops by this Common-Wealth; and by Order of the Surveyor-General, with the Approbation of the Honourable the Executive-Council, I have Surveyed, on the Fourth Day of November 1785, the above described Tract of Two hundred Acres of Land, and Allowance of Six per cent for Roads, &c. No. 1149 —
