



In Pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania, passed the twenty-fourth day of February, One-thousand Seven hundred and eighty-five, entitled an Act "for directing the Mode of distributing the Donation Lands, promised to the Troops by this Commonwealth, and by order of the Surveyor General, with the Approbation of the Honourable the Executive Council. I have surveyed on the tenth day of October, One-thousand seven hundred and eighty-five, the above described Tract of Two-hundred Acres of Land and Allowance for Roads, &c. No 590, situate in District No III, on the West Side of the Alligany River, in the County of Westmoreland.
