



Situate in White Deer township Union (late Berks) County Surveyed the 31st day of August 1832 by virtue of an order of Survey granted to Frederic Kneible dated the 3^d day of April 1769 N^o 1727. Containing three hundred and twenty Acres with the usual Allowance &c.

Note: The same tract of land was Surveyed the 2^d day of June 1794 for William Armstrong in pursuance of his order dated the 3^d day of April 1769 N^o — And now owned and occupied by James Sanderson in right of the said William Armstrong.
