



Draft of a Tract of land situate in Montgomery township (formerly Peters township Franklin County containing One Hundred & Forty Six Acres Eighty three perches & allowance of six per Cent for Roads &c surveyed the 11<sup>th</sup> of April 1829 in pursuance of a contract with the Board of Property for carrying into effect the several acts of Assembly relating to Proprietary Rights &c. Which was surveyed on an application granted John Shorefield dated the 15<sup>th</sup> of October 1766 No. 1533 under which the present Owners Claim John Whitmore's heirs Owners & Occupiers Montgomery Township N<sup>o</sup> 4484 - N<sup>o</sup> 1533 - Pat<sup>d</sup>.
