No. 1. represented by the dotted lines is a draft of a tract of land surveyed for Henry Brewer the 21st day of March 1785 in pursuance of a Warrant dated the 2nd day of March 1785. This Survey Interferes One Hundred and One Acres and One Hundred & twenty four perches With the George Rush tract - George Rush conveyed to William Hart who conveyed to Widow Moorhouse who conveyed to Henry Brewer who obtained the aforesaid Warrant and then devised the same to his heirs - who conveyed to Henry Brewer the present owner.
