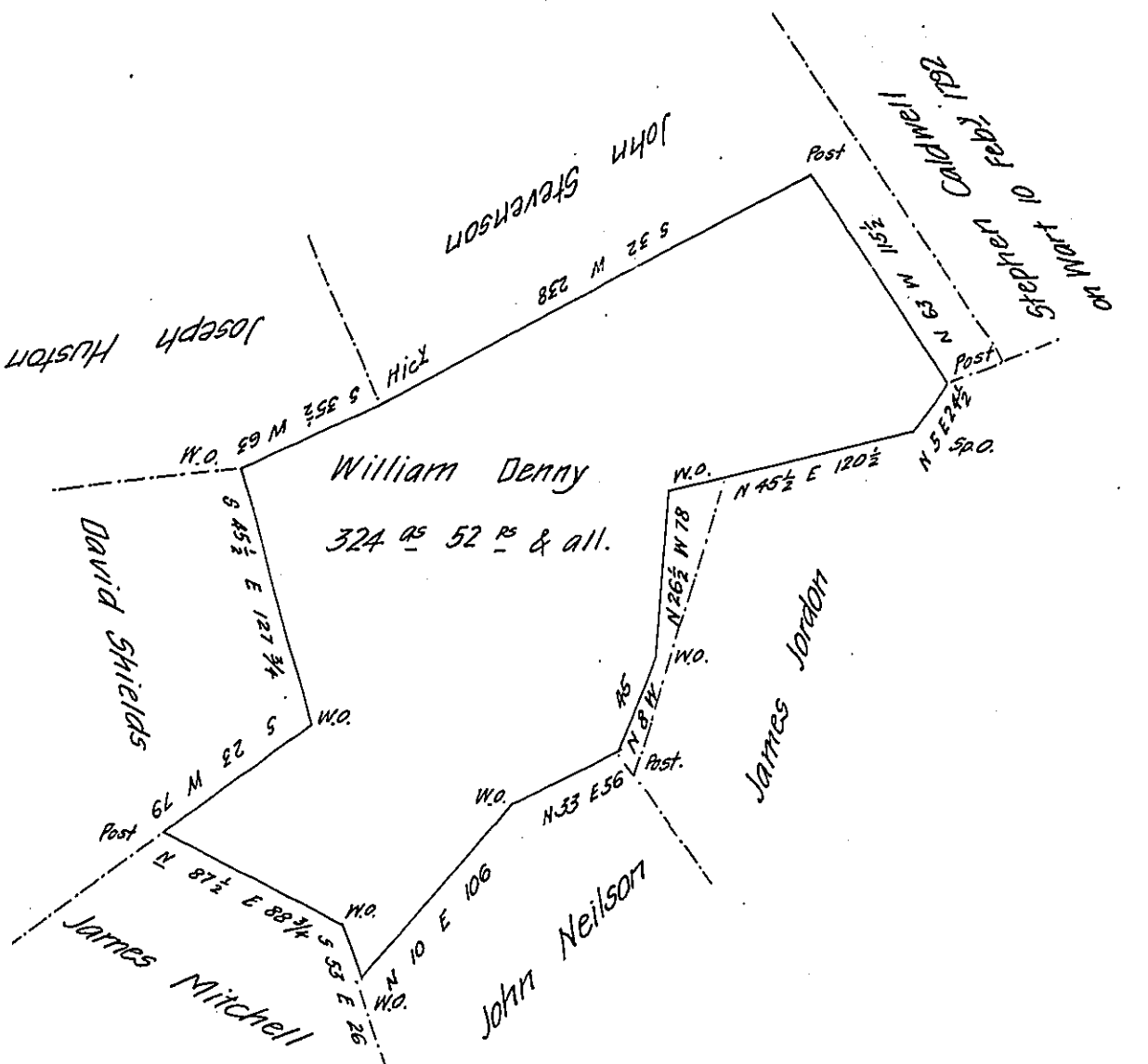

Located by virtue of an Order of Survey to William Denny for 200 Acres "joining James Mitchell David Shields Stephen Caldwell James Jordan John Nielson John Stephenson and Joseph Huston in Letterkenny Township" dated 8 April 1767 N^o 3376. And in pursuance of a contract with the Board of Property for carrying into effect the several Acts of Assembly relating to unpatented Lands under Proprietary rights &. &.

Report - The above Tract is wholly covered by a survey of 324 a 52 ps & allowan. made the 27 May 1785 on Warrant to Francis Campbell & John Mitchell bearing date 7 July 1784, and patented as tis said - on said Warrt.

Note; - Although the Quantity returned on Denny's Order greatly exceeds that mentioned in his application; yet the whole of the Tract is fairly embraced by the boundaries described in said Order - & information states that Denny once contended for the land; but no evidence of survey. Moses Kirkpatrick Esq^r & David Shields as tenants in common hold part of the land occupant Philip Shatzer - Moses Besore owner & occupier of the balance all claiming under the title founded on Campbell & Mitchells Warrant.
