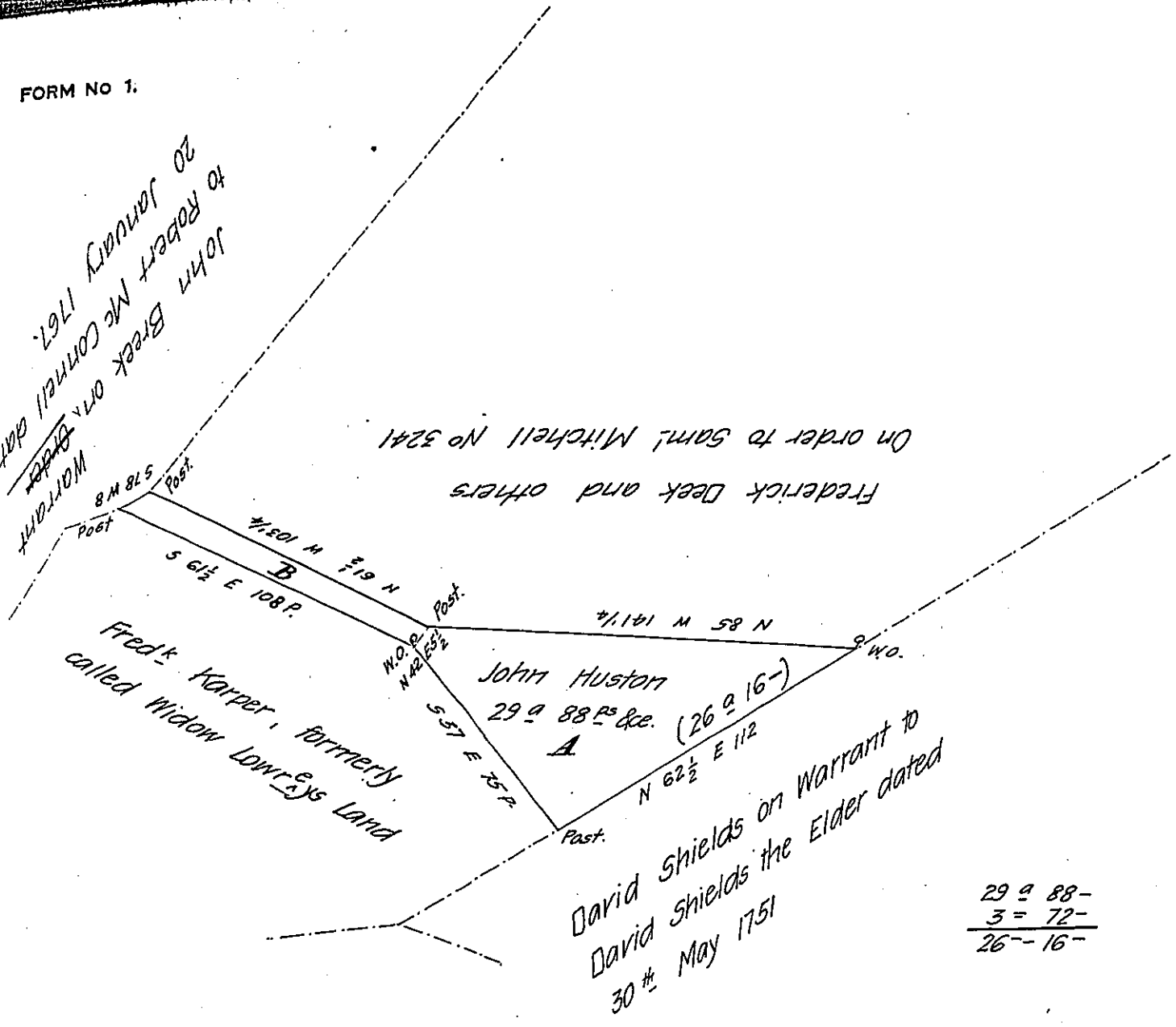

Draught of a Tract of Land situate in Letterkenny Township in the County of Franklin containing twenty nine Acres eight eight perches and allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. Surveyed the 7th Octr 1829 in pursuance of a contract with the Board of Property for carrying into effect the several acts of Assembly relating to unpatented lands under Proprietary rights &c. And by virtue of an Order of Survey dated 8th April 1767 N^o 3375 Granted to John Huston "for 100 Acres" joining David Shields, Saml Mitchell, Widow Lowrey and Robert McConnell in Letterkenny Township"
