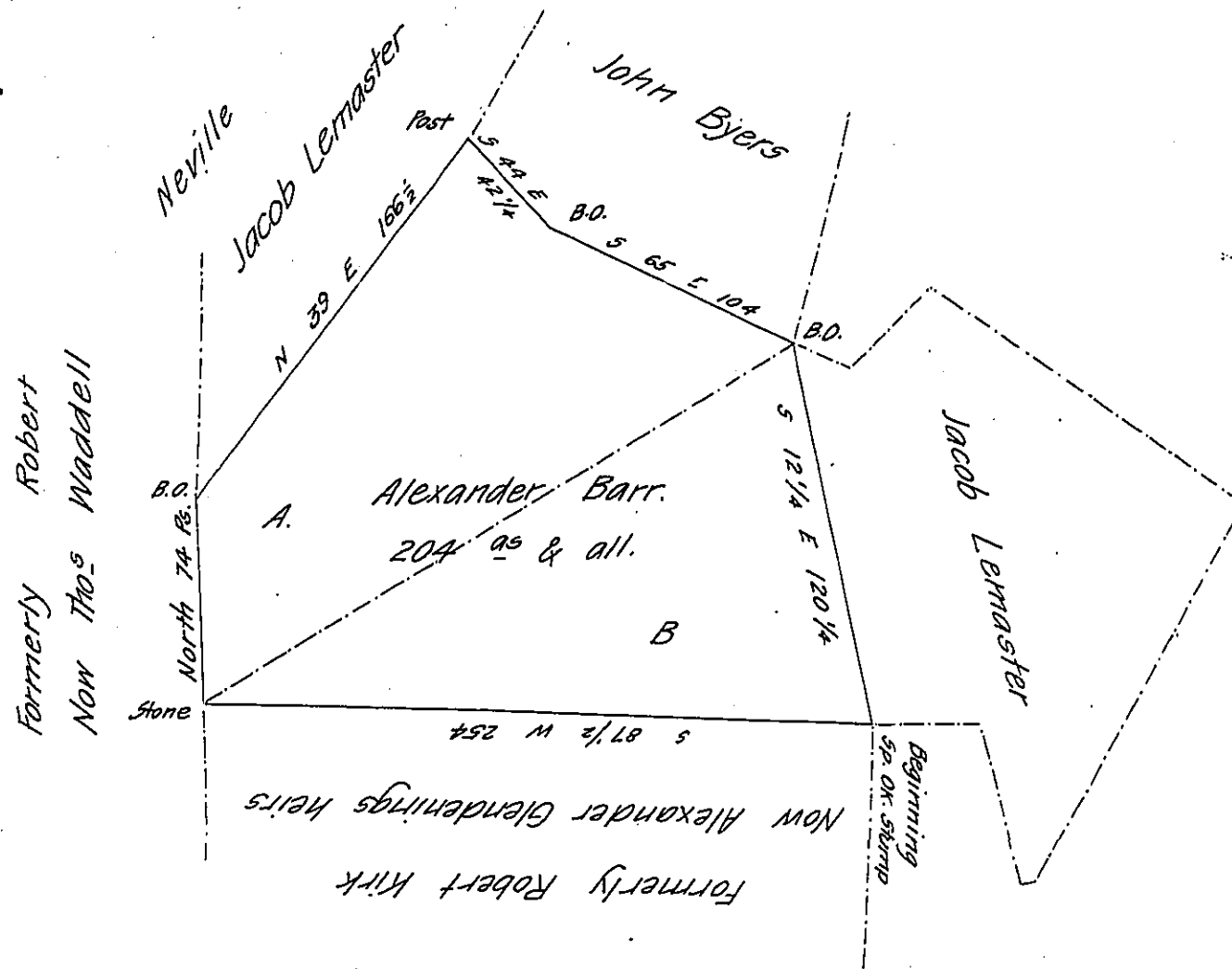


FORM NO 1.



Draft of a tract of land situate in Peters township Franklin County containing two hundred & four Acres & allowance of six per cent for roads &c. Surveyed the 19<sup>th</sup> of December 1828 (on an application granted Alexander Barr for 200<sup>ac</sup> of land in Peters township bounded by Robert Neville & Robert Kirk dated the 30<sup>th</sup> of March 1767 No. 3271.) In pursuance of a Contract with the Board of Property for carrying into effect the Several Acts of Assembly relating to Proprietary Rights &c.

The part of the above survey marked A includes a Survey of 98<sup>ac</sup> 100 per & all which was Surveyed on a warrant granted Samuel Mc Bride dated the 16<sup>th</sup> of Feby 1773. The part marked B. Containing 115<sup>ac</sup> 69 per & all is part of a Survey containing 222<sup>ac</sup> 110 per & all which was Surveyed on a Warrant granted James Bigger dated the 23<sup>d</sup> of Feby 1773.
