


FORM NO 1.

Surveyed the 19th of December 1828 (on an application granted Alexander Barr for 200^{as} of land in Peters township bounded by Robert Neville & Robert Kirk dated the 30th of March 1767 No 3271.) In pursuance of a Contract with the Board of Property for carrying into effect the Several Acts of Assembly relating to Proprietary Rights &c.

The part of the above survey marked A includes a Survey of 98 as 100 per & all which was Surveyed on a warrant granted Samuel McBride dated the 16th of Feby 1773. The part marked B containing 115 as 69 per & all. is part of a Survey Containing 222 as 110 per & all which was Surveyed on a Warrant granted James Bigger dated the 23^d of Feby 1773.
