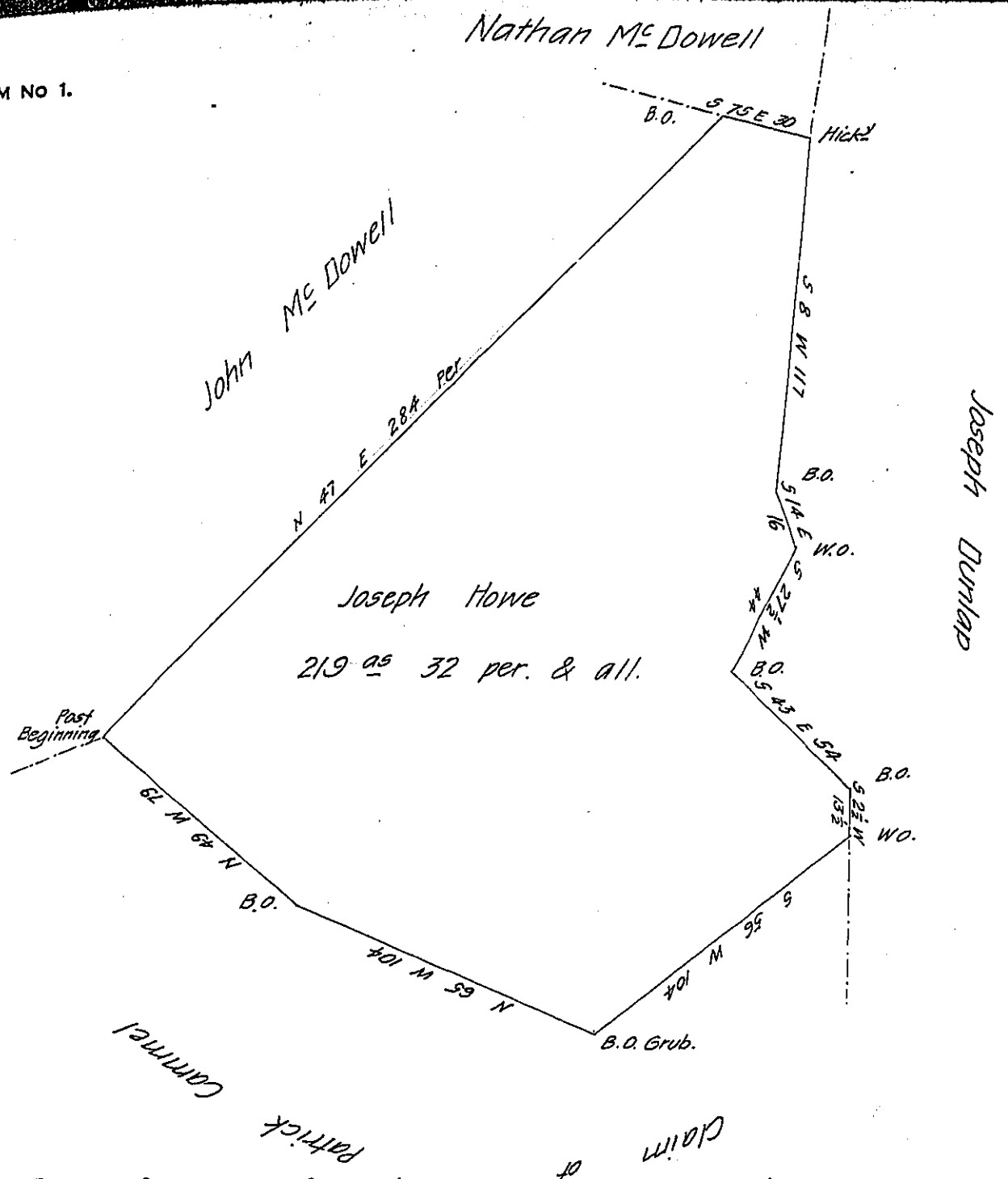


FORM NO 1.



*Draft of a tract of land situate in Peters township Franklin County containing Two Hundred & nineteen acres Thirty two perches & allowance of six per cent for roads &c. Which was surveyed the 21<sup>st</sup> of March 1769 on an order of Survey granted Joseph Howe for 200<sup>acs</sup> of land in Peters township bounded by John Mc Dowell, Robert Neville & his other land dated the 30<sup>th</sup> of March 1767 No. 3270 as appears from a rough draft in the D.S. office of Franklin County Certified the 13<sup>th</sup> of Feb<sup>y</sup> 1829 In pursuance of a Contract with the Board of Property for carrying into effect the several acts of Assembly relating to Proprietary Rights &c.*
