Which was surveyed on an Application granted Amos McGinley for 150^{ac} of land in Peters township joining the plantation of Dick Davis & William Duffield dated the 19th of March 1767 No 3111 as appears from a rough draft in the deputy surveyors office of Franklin County Certified the 6th of February 1829 in Pursuance of a Contract with the Board of Property for carrying into effect the several acts of Assembly relating to Proprietary Rights &c.
