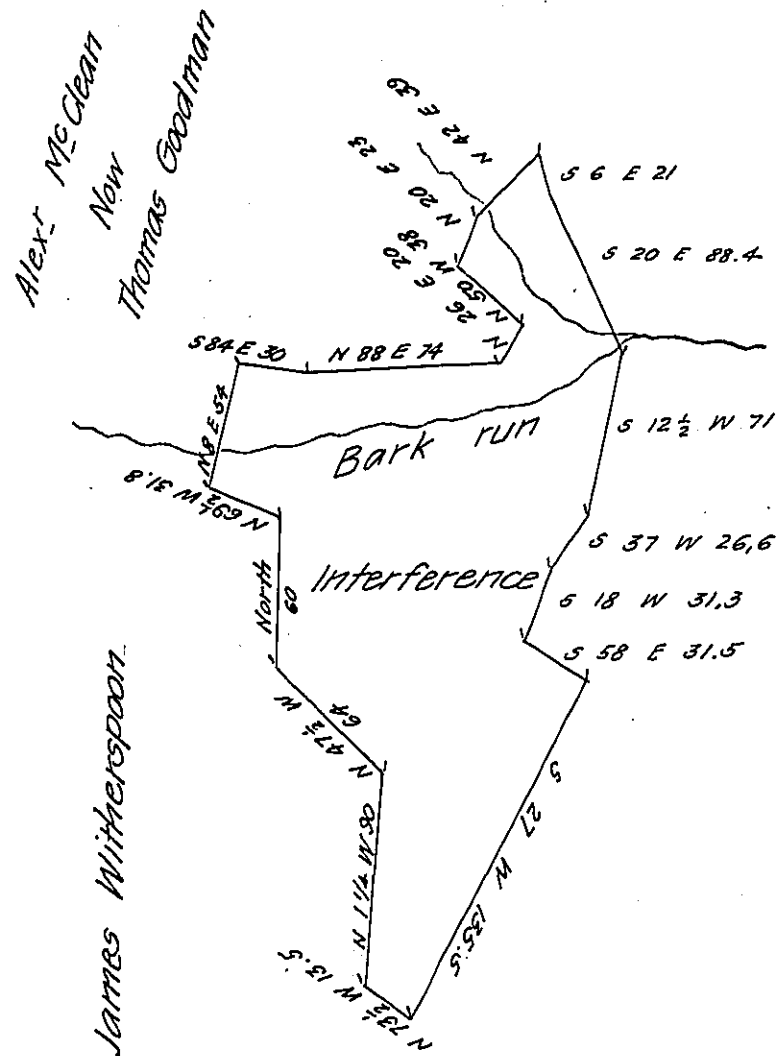

Application 3804 - 2<sup>d</sup> June 1767 - to Moses M<sup>c</sup>Lean for 150<sup>ac</sup> in Cumberland (now Franklin) Township

The above tract is an interference of a tract of 147<sup>ac</sup> 78<sup>ps</sup> and all<sup>ce</sup> surveyed on Warrant for 150<sup>ac</sup> to Moses McClean dated 17<sup>th</sup> May 1792 - Situate in Franklin Township Adams County now owned by Joseph Chamberlain.

Note - On the Commissioners Books I found 119<sup>ac</sup> 57<sup>ps</sup> returned as appraised for David Chamberlain on order N<sup>o</sup> 3806 - to W<sup>m</sup> M<sup>c</sup> Dowell dated June 2<sup>d</sup> 1767 - which I presume to be the same as above.
