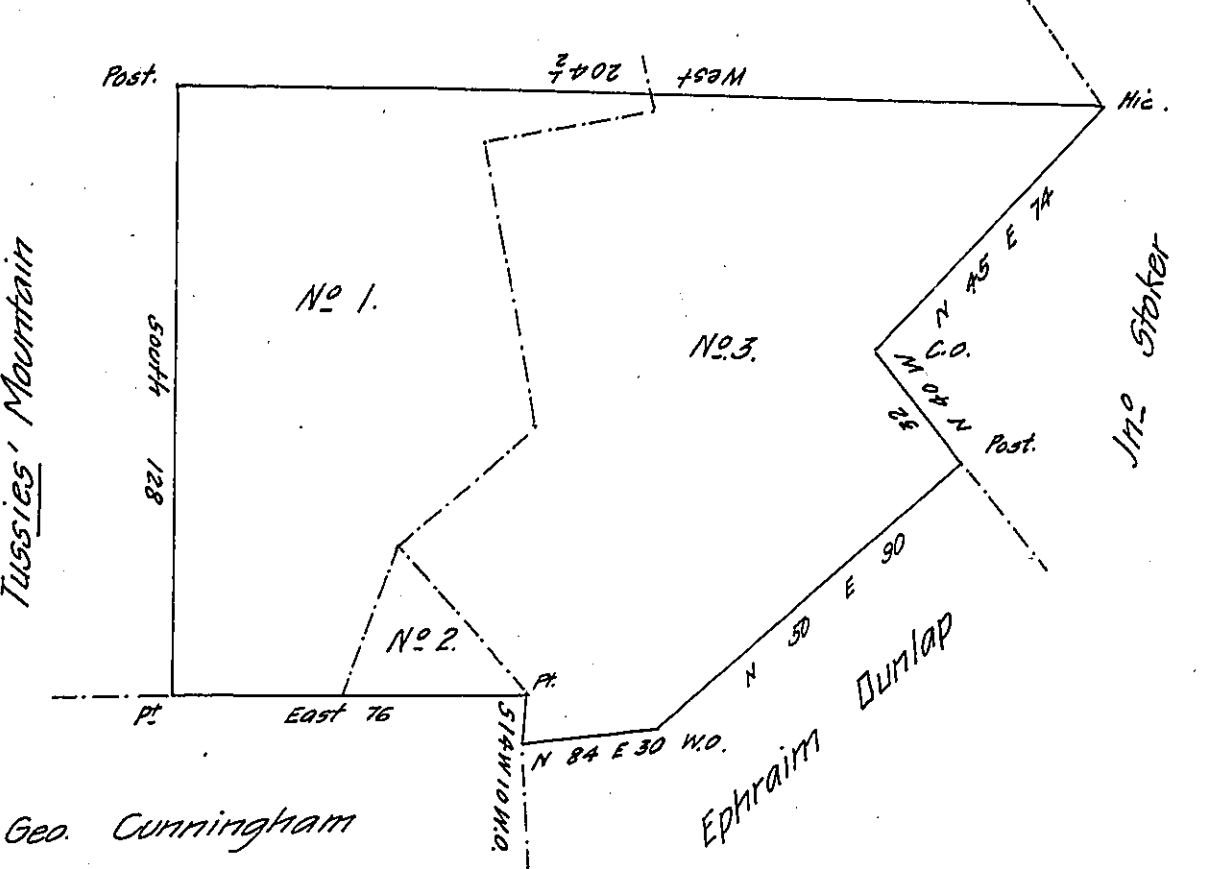

 Huntingdon County Containing one hundred and twenty acres and allowance
 of Six per Cent. Surveyed for James Hughs on order No. 3587 - dated the
 2nd day of May 1767

James Dunlap not found. Henry Cannon not Pat.

No. 2. represents part of a Survey made for John Cannon on an Improvement made
 about 30 years ago. This Survey interferes three acres and one hundred and
 forty two perches with the James Hughs tract. John Cannon conveyed to Benjin
 R. Morgan who is the present owner.

No. 1. represents part of a survey made for James Dunlap on Warrant dated
 the 15th day of January 1794 - This Survey interferes thirty nine acres and
 twenty seven perches with the James Hughs tract. James Dunlap conveyed to
 John Cannon who conveyed to Benjamin R. Morgan the present owner.

No. 3. represents part of a Survey made for Henry Cannon on Warrant dated
 the 25th Febuary 1794

This Surv y interferes seventy seven acres with the James Hughs
 tract Henry Cannon conveyed to John Cannon who conveyed to Joseph
 Shaw.

 the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made
 conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of
