



Situate part in Heidelberg and part in Manhime (formerly all in Manhime) township York County Surveyed in pursuance of an Application No 2893 granted to Thomas Shewell dated 24th february 1767 for 100^{ac} - May 31st 1831 - the above tract of Land is Included in a patent granted to Daniel Utz the 19th day of July 1794 on two Warrants granted to Tobias Stoyer One for 100^{ac} and one for 50^{ac} each dated the 28th day of October 1746 the whole of said tract is owned and in possession of Andrew Utz and Henry Stoyer but no evidence of Shewell (the name of the Office Right) ever being in possession or ever claimed it.
