No 1. represented by dotted lines is part of a draft of a tract of Land Surveyed for Jacob Bragorner on Warrant dated the 8th day of July 1796 this tract interferes One hundred and forty eight acres and One Hundred and Nine perches with the John Archer Survey. Jacob Bragorner bought from Samuel Riddle Esqr who claimed under John Archer and then conveyed to Luke Fetters the present owner of part of said tract. — No 2 represented by dotted lines is part of a draft of a tract of land surveyed for John Gordon on Warrant dated the 19th day of October 1792 this tract interferes Eighty one Acres and sixty three perches with the John Archer Survey — John Gordon purchased from Samuel Riddle Esqr who claimed under John Archer — and then devised the same to Absalom Gordon the present owner No 3. is part of a draft of a tract of land Surveyed for John Gordon on Warrant dated the 19th day of October 1792 — this tract interferes Eight acres and One hundred and eighteen perches with the John Archer Survey — John Gordon devised the same to Absalom Gordon who also purchased from Samuel Riddle Esqr. who claimed under John Archer — Absalom Gordon is the present owner.
