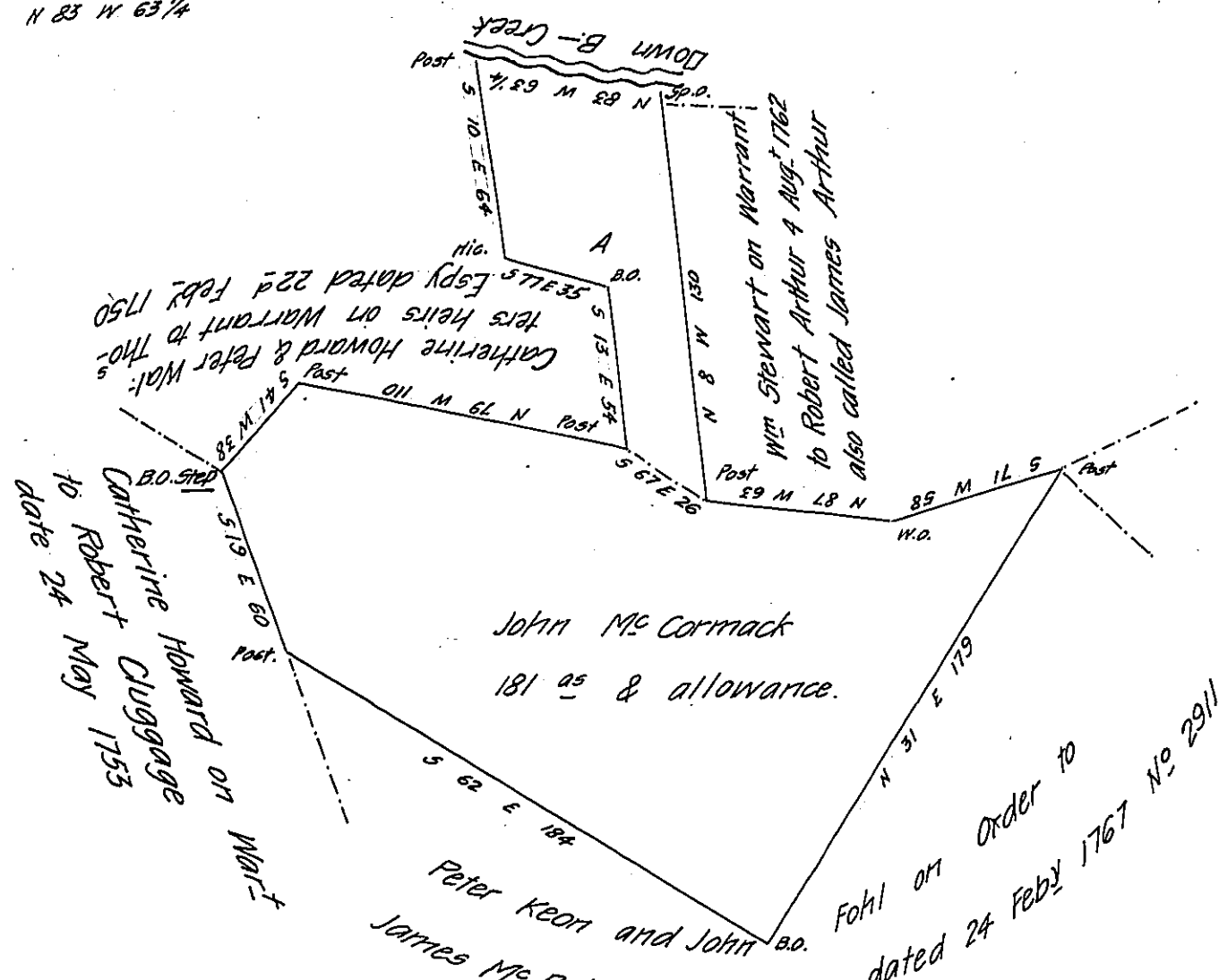

Draught of a Tract of land situate in Hamilton Township Franklin County (formerly Cumberland) containing 181 acres and allowance of six per cent for roads & surveyed 19th September 1828 on an order of survey dated the 17th of February 1767 No 2814 Granted to John Mc Cormack for 300 A^s "On the West side of Conococheague Creek joining James McBride James Arthur and John Glenn" and in pursuance of a Contract with the Board of Property for carrying into effect the several Acts of Assembly relating to Unpatented Lands under Proprietary Rights &c &c To Jacob Spangler Esq^r }

Note. The part marked A of the above tract appears to have been Survey'd 23^d Jany 1770 under the direction of James McBride on the above Order of Survey.

Report. The above Tract is wholly the same as a Tract of 174 A^s which was Survey'd 13 May 1788 for James McBride in Pursuance of his Warrant dated 22^d February 1787 Pat^d.
