



The part marked A is an Interference of 31^{as} 128^{as} & all^{as} Surveyed on Application No 3616 - dated 8th May 1767 - 4th day of August 1767 unto Nicholas Meyer and John Peckar called "Brotherhood" in Reading Township Adams County - a Caveat it appears had been entered by John Horner - It was however patented by T. & R. Penn by Patent dated 9th June 1768 to Nicholas Meyer & John Peckar - It is now ^{owned} by Doct^r Thomas Stephens in Trust it appears for himself & others.

The part marked B is an Interference of a Tract of 33 1/4 acres patented on warrant dated 13th Sept 1743 to Michael Hoffman by Patent dated 3rd Sept 1809 - enrolled in Pat. Book H. Vol. 1st page 437 - now owned by Doct^r Thomas Stephens above named in Reading Township Adams County
