To Jacob Spangler Esqr. S.G. John Spenser - Pat^d

The red lines represent part of a Survey made for John Spenser on Warrant dated the 22nd day of March 1785 - This Survey interferes one hundred and seven Acres with the John Mitchell tract - It appears that John Mitchell conveyed to Daniel Anderson who conveyed to John Spenser who obtained the aforesaid Warrant and conveyed to John Kerr whose Executors conveyed to John Ambrose whose heirs conveyed to Joseph Jones who conveyed to Hiram Williamson the present owner.
