



Situate in Buffalo Township Union (late Berks) County  
Surveyed the 8<sup>th</sup> day of May 1833 by virtue of an Order Granted  
to Peter Braght dated the 3<sup>d</sup> day of April 1769 No 2336  
containing One hundred & sixty three acres with the usual allowance &c.

Note The same tract of land was surveyed the 4<sup>th</sup> day of October 1769 for Andrew Culbertson in pursuance of his Order dated the 3<sup>d</sup> day of April 1769 - No 296 And now owned and occupied by John Cowdan in right of the sd. Andrew Culbertson.
