Note - The same interferences & is included in two surveys in the names of James Allen & John Moore both made the 9<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup>. of August 1769, on orders dated 3<sup>d</sup>. April 1769 & are now owned by Samuel Wilson & others in right of the said Allen & Moore - The Moore survey is represented by the Blue lines.
