



Situate in Kelly township Union (late Berks) County surveyed the 4th day of September A. Dom. 1832 for Henry Harper by virtue of his order-bearing date the 3^d day of April 1769 No. 2060 Containing Two Hundred & ninety nine acres & Eighty one perches with the usual allowance of six per Cent &c.

A part of the above described Tract of land viz. 201⁹ & 40 per. &c. was surveyed to Richard Edwards the 12th day of August 1769 in pursuance of his order dated 3^d day of April 1769 No. 714 - The other part of the above tract containing ninety eight acres and thirty three perches is part of a tract surveyed for John Moore the 9th day of August 1769 in pursuance of his order No. 479 dated 3^d April 1769 & now owned & possessed by Roan McClure & Samuel Wilson in right of Richard Edwards & John Moore.
