Situate in White Deer township Union [late Berks] County surveyed the 4th day of August 1832 by virtue of an order granted to John Logan dated the 3^d day of April 1769. No. 1027. Containing three hundred & Six Acres with the usual Allowance of six per Cent &c.

Note. The above mentioned tract of land was surveyed the 28th day of June 1769, for Lemuel Pearson in pursuance of his order dated the 3^d day of April 1769, No. 775, the same now owned and occupied by Lazarus Finney in right of the said Lemuel Pearson.
