



Situate in Kelly township, Union [late Berks] County, Surveyed the 9th day of September 1833 by virtue of an order of Survey granted to David Morgan dated the 3^d day of April 1769, No. 1026, Containing three hundred & twenty nine acres & 35 perches with the usual allowance of Six per Cent &c.

Note - The same tract of land was Surveyed the 28th day of July 1772 for Thomas McFaddon in pursuance of his order dated the 3^d day of April 1769, No 873. And now owned and occupied by Adam Geyer & others in right of the said Thomas McFaddon.
