



Situate in Buffalo township Union [late Berks] County, surveyed the 4th day of November 1832 by virtue of an order granted to James Johnston dated the 3d day of April 1769, No. 1532 containing two hundred acres with the usual allowance &c.

Note The same tract of land was surveyed the — day of February 1769, in pursuance of a special grant dated the — day of — 1769, to James Bremner, and now owned and occupied by John Reber in right of the said James Bremner.
