



Situate in Augusta Township, Northumberland County, On the East side of the Susquehanna—opposit the Isle of Q and adjoining to Hollowing to Run. Surveyed on the 6th day of November, A.D. 1835. by virtue of an Order dated 3^d day of April, 1769. No. 1388. granted to John Wikoff. Containing two hundred fifty one acres & one hundred perches with the usual Alls. &c.

Note. the same tract of land was Surveyed on the 23rd day of August 1769. unto Arthur Aughmuty in pursuance of his Order dated the 24th day of May. 1769. No. 46. and is now owned and occupied by William R. Jones in right of said Arthur Aughmuty.
