



Situate in Turbut Township, Northumberland County, about $5\frac{1}{2}$ miles from the mouth of the warrior Run & on said Run. Surveyed on the 27th. October, A.D. 1835. by virtue of an Order dated 3d. April, 1769. No. 1413. granted to James Warnock. Containing three hundred Acres with the usual allowance of Six Per Cent &c.

Note. the same tract of land was Surveyed on the—day of—AD. 17— for Edward Rairdon in pursuance of Order dated the 3rd. day of April. A.D. 1769^{No. 713.} and is now owned and occupied by Andrew Tenbrook in right of said Edward Rairdon.
