



Situate in Turbut township Northumberland County. Surveyed the 3d. day of October A.D. 1835. by virtue of an Order dated the 3d. day of April, 1769. No. 1375. granted to James Loaf Containing three Hundred and twenty six Acres with the usual allowance &c.

Note. The same tract is part of a larger tract of land which was surveyed the 23rd. day of May, 1769.

Captain William Piper in pursuance of his order dated the 4th. day of February, 1769. And is now owned & occupied by Samuel McCormick & others in right of of the said Capt. William Piper.
