



Situate in West Buffalo township Union County, Surveyed the 18th day of July 1834. by virtue of an Order granted to Henry Neil dated the 3d day of April, 1769. No. 1364. Containing two hundred forty six acres and 88 perches with the usual allowance of Six pr. cent &c.

Note. The same ^{tract} of land was surveyed to Ensign Forster the day of February 1769. being the allotment which fell to him on the Division of 8000 Acres. Surveyed for the officers of Col. Turbut Francis Corp's in pursuance of an order of Survey No. 1. and now laid out into town Lots in right of the said Ensign Forster.
