



Situate in West Buffalo township, Union County, Surveyed the 18th. day of March. 1835 by virtue of an Order of Survey granted to Hugh Means dated the 3d. day of April, 1769. No. 1285. Containing two Hundred & fifty eight Acres & one Hundred & fifty three perches with the usual Allowance of 6 per Cent &c.

Note. The above tract of land was surveyed the 14th. day of August. 1769 for George Ryne in pursuance of his order dated the 3d. of April, 1769. No. 2017. and is now owned & occupied by the Heirs of Jesse Methers & others in right of the said George Ryne.
