



Situate in White Deer township, Union County. Surveyed the 10th day of August 1832 by virtue of an order granted to Christopher Quigly dated the 3d day of April, 1769. No. 1222 Containing two Hundred & Sixty five Acres & thirty six perches with the usual allowance &c. & designated by the yellow lines.

Note. The same tract of land interferes & is included in a survey that was made for William Richards the 14th day of October, 1773 in pursuance of his order Dated the 3d day of April, 1769. No. 1643. & now owned & occupied by Samuel Keim & others in right of the said William Richards. and is Designated by Green lines.
