



Situate in White Deer township Union (late Berks) County Surveyed the 1<sup>st</sup> day of August A.D. 1832 by Virtue of an Order granted to Jacob Hall bearing date the 3<sup>d</sup> day of April 1769 N<sup>o</sup> 1228. Containing three hundred and Six Acres with the Usual Allowance of Six P<sup>r</sup> Cent &c.

Note. The above described tract of land was Surveyed the 18<sup>th</sup> day of February 1775 for Michael Weyland in pursuance of his Application N<sup>o</sup> 32 dated the 3<sup>d</sup> day of April 1769.
