



Situate in Union township, Union County, Surveyed the 23^d. day of March, 1837. by virtue of an Order Granted to Caleb Carmalt dated the 3^d. day of April, 1769, No. 1158. Containing two Hundred & fifty nine Acres & thirty three perches with the usual allowance &c. about half a mile from Gabriels land.

Note. The same tract of land was Surveyed the 27th. day of April 1775 for Ludwick Karcher in pursuance of his warrant dated the 25th. October 1774 & is now owned by Isaac Eyer in right of the said Ludwiq Karcher.
