



Situate in West Buffalo township Union County. Surveyed the 26th day of July 1836 by Virtue of an Order Dated the 3^d day of April 1769 N^o 648. Granted to George Miller, Containing One Hundred & forty nine Acres and One hundred & twenty five perches with the Usual allowance &c. & is designated by the Red lines.

Note. The same tract of land interferes & is included in a Survey made the 18th day of April 1800. for John Loudon in pursuance of his Warrant Dated the 15th day of January 1793. Containing 271.⁹⁵ 104 perches &c. And is now Owned & Occupied by John Breckly & others in right of the said John Loudon.

And is designated by the Green lines.
