



Situate in Kelly township Union County Surveyed the 6th day of March 1833 by Virtue of an Order granted to James McConnel dated the 4. day of April 1769. N. 2794 Containing three hundred and Six Acres with the Usual Allowance &c.

Note. The Same tract of land was Surveyed the 17th day of March 1769 for Col^o Turbut Francis being part of his Allotment which fell to him on the Division of a tract of 1105 Acres Surveyed for the Officers of Col. Turbut Francis Corps in pursuance of an Order of Survey dated the 9th day of March 1769. And now Owned and Occupied by David Lynn and John Lynn in right of the said Col. Francis.
