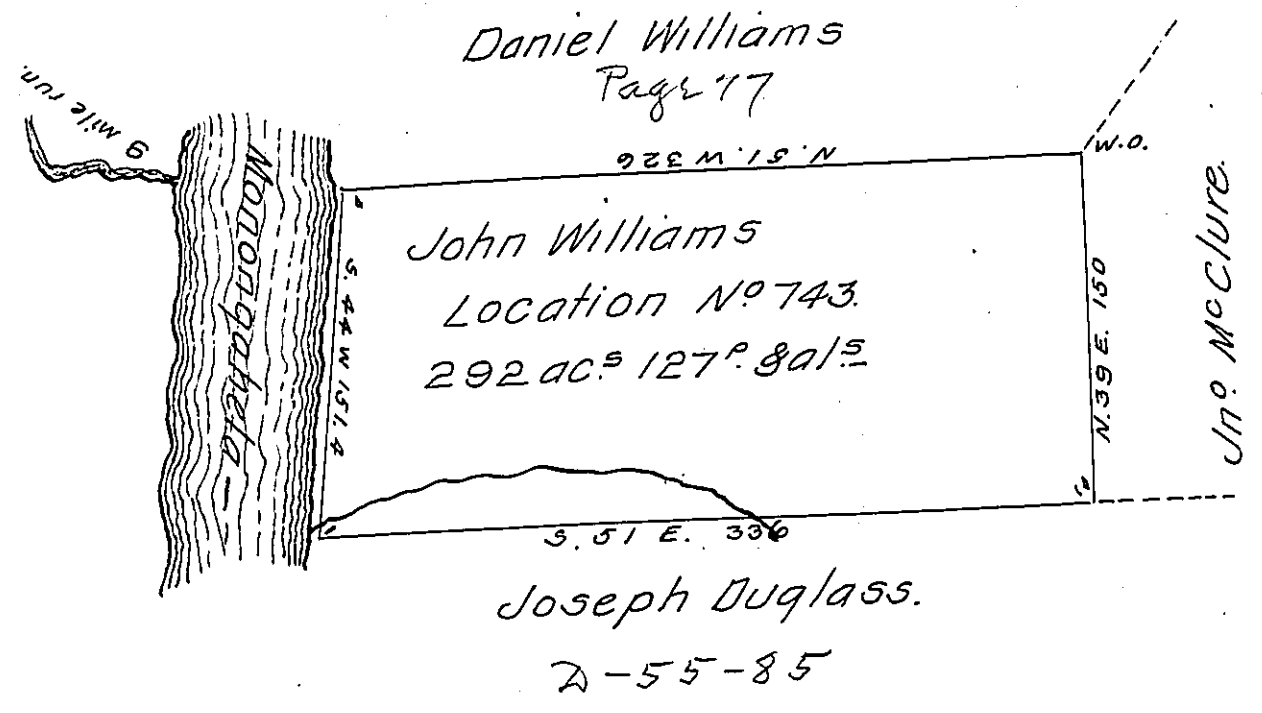

Containing two hundred Ninety two Ac^s 127 perches & all^s. situate in Mifflin Township Allegheny County.
