



Draught of a Tract of land situate in Letterkenny Township in the County of Franklin, containing one hundred and fifty Acres & sixty one perches and allowance of Six per cent for Roads &c. Surveyed the 7th October 1829. In pursuance of a contract with the Board of Property for carrying into effect the several Acts of Assembly relating to unpatented Lands under Proprietary Rights &c. And by virtue of An Order of Survey dated the 1st day of August 1766. N^o 581. Granted to Bartle Shee for 150 Acres of Land. In Letterkenny Township at the foot of the North Mountain joining Robert McConnells Surveyed line on the East.

Report.
 The above Tract is included within the lines of a larger Tract of 302^a 133^p & al. Surveyd. 2nd June 1786, on a Warrant to Andrew Boggys dated the 23^d August 1784, & appears to have been Returned to the Board of Property in dispute between the Assignees of said Boggys on one Side, and Robert, James & John McConnell on the other, who claimed the Land by virtue of their Warrant, dated 7 Jan. 1785 - Decision of the Board not ascertained - The blank lines represent the balance of Survey on Boggys Warrant.
 Note. Dewalt Keeffer, Fred^l Deck, & John Break owners & occupiers - Note. further no evidence appears, of Shees Order being executed on the Land.
