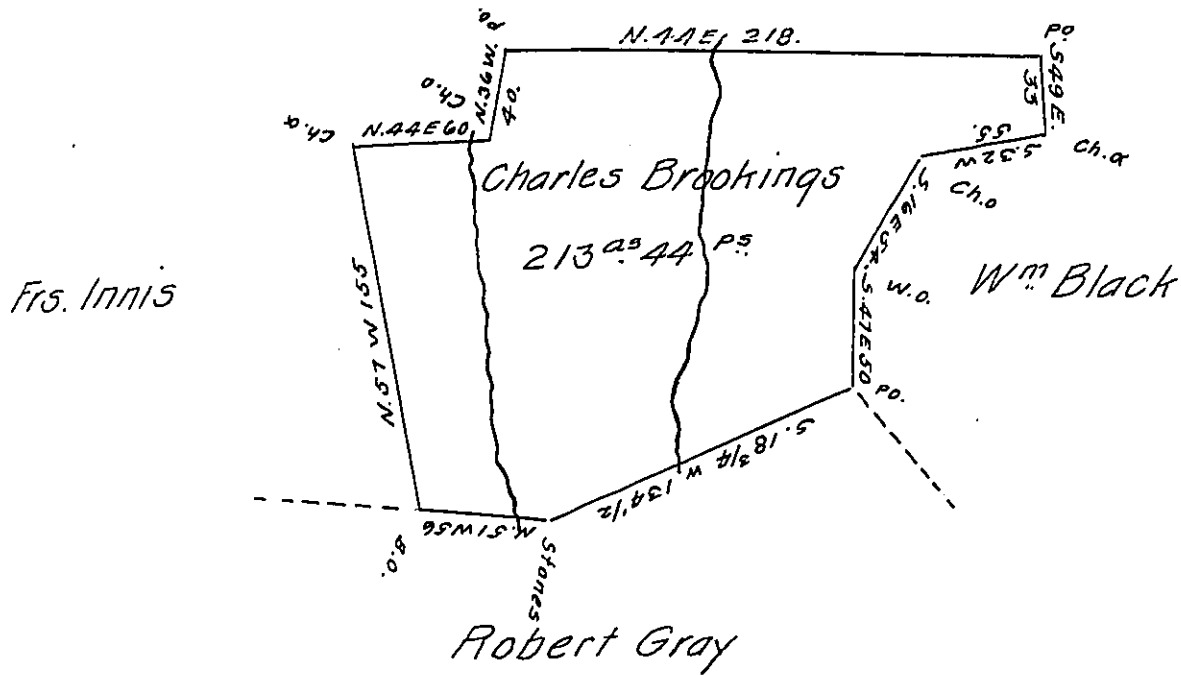


Shade Mountain
