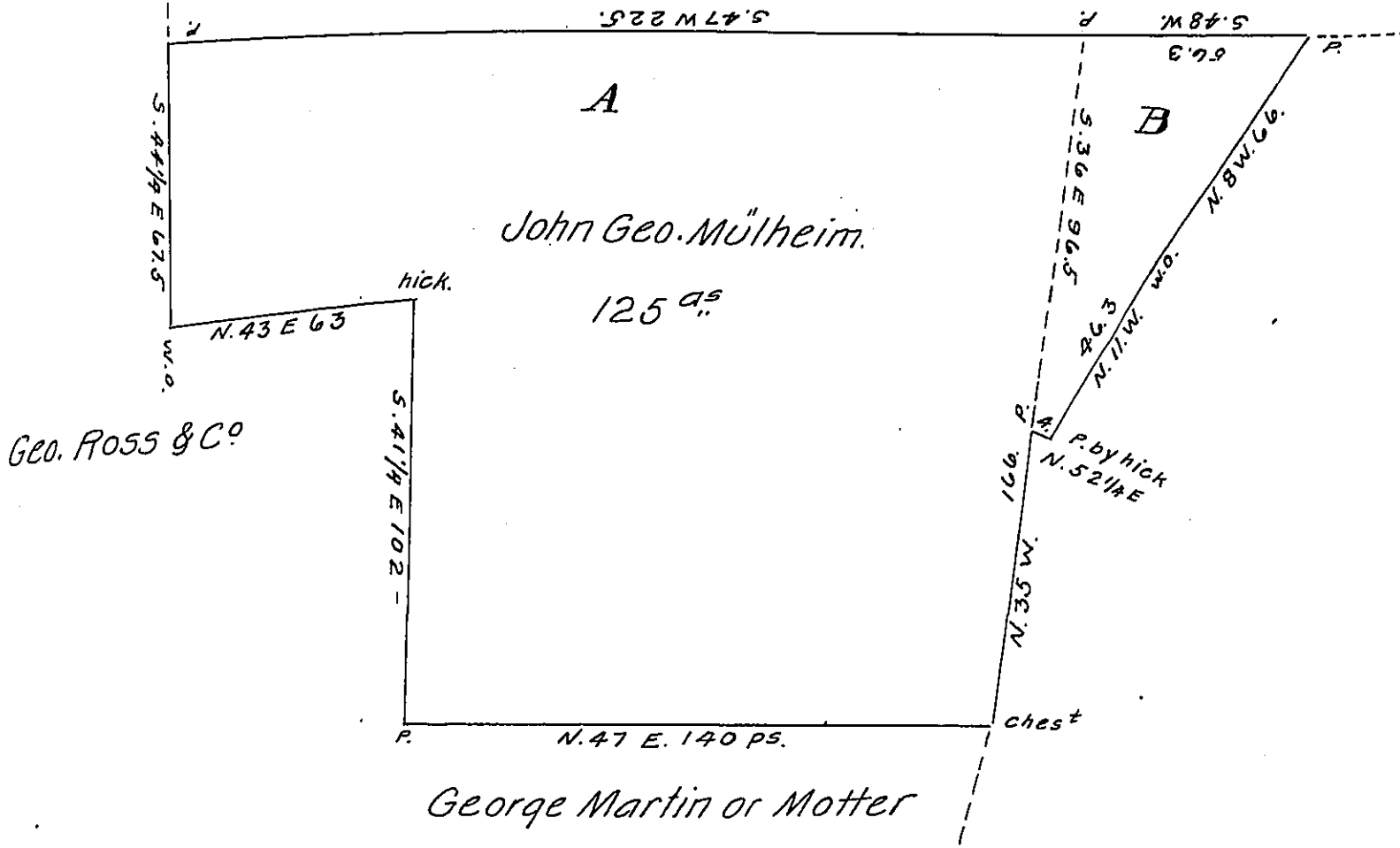


Sam! Wildesine in right of Catherine Wildesine



Application N^o 70-1st Aug^t 1766 to John Geo. Mülheim for 125^{acs} in Manheim Town^P.

The part above marked A. is an Interference of a Tract of 163^{acs} 139^{ps} & All^{ce} Surveyed on War^t to George Charles Wildesine dated April 30th 1765- & the part marked B. was Surveyed on Order N^o 4167- dated July 13th 1767. Containing 16^{acs} 108^{ps} & all^{ce} to George Mülheim. The Whole situate in Manheim Town^P. - now owned by Christian Mülheim.
