Vol. 10. page 70. on application N^o 1560. dated the 17 day of October 1766. granted to William Nuna, the part B. Containing 27. A. 150 ps. and Allowance. which is Included in a patent granted to Francis Himes dated the 5th day of August 1790. enrolled in patent Book N^o 16. page 355. on Warrant dated the 29th day of June 1785 granted to Said Himes. but there is no evedence of John Geo. Milheim the Name of the Office Right ever being in possession or Ever Claimed it.
