



Situate on Poplar Run and Partly in Frankstown township Huntingdon County and Greenfield township Bedford County - Containing three Hundred and twenty nine acres and allowance of Six per Cent. Surveyed for Thomas Reed on order No 25 dated the 1st August 1766.

The dotted lines represent the draught of a tract of Land Surveyed for John Gilbert on Warrant dated first day of August 1766. This tract interferes one Hundred and Seventy four acres and one hundred and eight perches with the Thomas Reed Survey - John Gilbert conveyed to Samuel Wallace who conveyed to Abel James & Henry Drinker. Abel James conveyed to Henry Drinker who conveyed to Patrick Cassidy who devised the same to Peter & James Cassidy the present owners.
