The dotted lines represent part of the draught of a Survey made for Cabob Massey on Warrant dated the 18th day of September 1784. This Survey interferes one Hundred and Seventeen acres and one hundred and fifty Six perches with the Andrew Boggs Senr. Survey - There is no person claiming under the Cabob Massey title. John Stewart Esqr. claims fifty acres of the Andrew Boggs Senr. Survey by virtue of an Improvement made a few years ago.
