



A Draft of Atract of Land Situate in Vells Valley Hopewell Township Bedford County. Containing One Hundred and fifty Acres & Allowance of Six percent for roads & 50. Surveyed for Adam McConnel on Order N^o 838 dated the 12th day of August 1766.

The Green lines represent the draft of Atract of land Surveyed for Alexander Alexander the 21st day of January 1794. on Warrant dated the 27th day of June 1786. This tract interferes one Hundred & fifty Acres with the Adam McConnel tract- Adam McConnel conveyed to Alexander Alexander who afterwards obtained the afore said Warrant and devised 100 acres to his daughter Agness who married John Gibson the present owner. Alexander Alexander devised the remaining 50 acres to his daughter Christianna and John Wishard. Christianna conveyed her Interest therein to John Wishard the present owner.
