



Situate in Conowago (Late Dover) township in the County of York. Containing within the Black Lines as above represented 144^{ac} 131^{ps} & the usual allowance. Surveyed on the 14th day of March 1831 in pursuance of Michel Long Jun's Application N^o 680 for 150^{ac} dated the 2^d day of August 1766. and also by virtue of the Contract with the Board of Property.

Report- The above is embraced in a Large Survey of 212^{ac} made in pursuance of a warrant granted to Michel Leidich dated the 6th day of March 1790. and Patented to him on this warrant the 12 of July 1793. - Owned and Occupied by Benjamin Welcome, Michel Shettle, Henry Stover Esq. Peter Brunner & George Auchenback. The Dotted Lines represent the balance of Leidich Survey. There is no evidence of Long ever being in possession.
