



Surveyed Land

Situate in White Deer township Union County. Surveyed the 10<sup>th</sup> day of May 1834 by Virtue of an Order granted to Thomas Mc Murray Dated the 3<sup>d</sup> day of April 1769 N<sup>o</sup> 587. Containing Two Hundred & Ninety four Acres & eighty seven perches & the Usual Allowance of Six per Cent &c. And is Designated by the Yellow lines.

Note. The above tract of land interferes & is included in a Survey made the 12<sup>th</sup> day of November 1794 for Charles Evans in pursuance of his Warrant Dated the 7<sup>th</sup> day of June 1794. and is unseated is Designated by the Green lines.
